Tanzanian Energy Minister Makamba Endorses Timely Energy Congress To Be Hosted In Dar es Salaam in 2022

Her Excellency President Samia Suluhu Hassan, who took office in March 2021, has made an effort to create a more conducive business environment and her newly appointed Energy Minister Makamba, is bullish about the government’s LNG aspirations, with negotiations starting up again between the Tanzanian government, Shell and Equinor about a Host Government Agreement (HGA) for a US\$30bn liquefied natural gas (LNG) project. Tanzanian leaders are hoping to come to an agreement with the companies by the end of this year.
